Dear Alex Zernopolsky,

If the passport states in the information page (i.e. the page which has the details of the holder of the passport) that his/her citizenship is Israel the traveler does not need a visa. If in the citizenship states something else, for example Russian, the traveler needs to apply for a visa. This is the information the Embassy has received from the Finnish Border Guard: <https://raja.fi/en/frontpage>

Do note that Finland does not accept extended Israeli passports/travel documents.
