Dear Mr. Zernopolsky,

As per Article 1 of the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Belarus and the Government of the State of Israel on visa exemption for holders of national passports (signed on September 19, 2014, came into force on November 26, 2015) the visa-free regime for short-term trips (up to 90 days of stay within 6 months from the date of first entry) applies to holders of national passports only (except of diplomatic and official ones).

According to Israeli Side it's only "darkon" that can be classified in this category.

Thus, to enter Belarus with any Israeli passport other than "darkon", a visa is required.

It should be also taken into account that the final decision on entry into Belarus is made by the border control service of the Republic of Belarus.


